

PROJECT PROFILE: Kingston Phase 2 Enabling Works

Duration	25 Weeks.
Quantities	12,000m3 of concrete demolition and processing 9,000m3 of contaminated material processed 20,000m3 of rock infill and armour works 60,000m3 of site won and import fills.
Description	The contract entailed demolition and infilling of an existing wet dock along with works associated with the remediation of a disused gasworks for housing on a site covering an area of 12.5 Ha.
Key Issues	Processes included crushing, screening and treatment of soils and water contaminated by metals, oils and invasive weed. Working within the existing dock required the use of marine plant and marine engineering techniques. In addition to earthworks RJT undertook the installation of main sewers for the proposed housing development RJT excavations performed the roll of principle contractor. The works were completed to programme and at below the clients target cost.
